President Justin Johnson called the meeting to order at 7:08 p.m.

Meeting Agenda

Torrington Show

Justin received word from the Cobblestone that they would be agreeable to rooms for \$99/room. Jack suggested that Justin ask for 1 free room for every 10 reservations. Justin said he would check into that arrangement.

Justin said the cattle (500 head) have been confirmed for the Torrington show. The contract will go out soon to the cattle provider. He suggested that we use the same schedule as what Miller's used at their show earlier this month. Shaun made a motion to have 3 days of weekend shows with the Classic and Derby classes being run at the beginning of each day. Wylie seconded the motion. Motion carried by voice vote. Kelly will contact the NCHA and also change the flyer. She will contact Anne to change our website.

The AQHA classes will be held as a class within a class. The Jr. will be run with the 25k class, the Sr. will be run with the Open class and the Amateur will be run with the Non Pro class. There will also be a Youth AQHA class. Jack reminded us that back numbers are required for the AQHA entries. Justin will check with the facility to see if they have those available. Jack noted that Purina has donated back numbers free of charge in the past. A copy of the Judges sheets will need to be forwarded to the AQHA.

There was discussion about having enough cattle to have a fresh cattle practice the day before the show starts. It does not look like that will be an option. Jack suggested that we flip the arena so that the used cattle practice is inside and the flag practice is outside of the

door. He felt we would have a much larger number of practice runs this way. He also felt 2-3 loads of sand needed to be added to the warm up area. By flipping the arena there will not be a need for a Judge's stand as they will be able to sit in the grandstand.

Jack brought up that we need a GOOD concession stand. He was not happy with who was there last September. It was felt that a concession truck would be best as the kitchen does not provide adequate appliances.

The Fee Schedule was discussed. Shaun made a motion that we use "used" cattle for the "used" cattle classes. Doyle seconded the motion. Motion carried by voice vote. If, by chance, we have extra fresh cows on Sunday, we will offer them in a particular class.

A motion to adjourn was made by Justin and seconded by Shaun. Motion carried and the meeting was adjourned.
